Dear Parishioners and Faithful of Immaculate Conception Church in Kelowna

We continue to follow the protocols issued by His Excellency and BC Health Authority to worship in our parishes throughout the Diocese of Nelson. We are following a list of procedures for our faith community to be able to attend Mass again.

Our Parish is allowed **50 people in total for each mass.**

Mass is offered at the following times:

8:00 am (church) Rosary – 7:30 am Weekdays -

Wednesdays -**5:00 pm** (church)

Saturdays -9:00 am (church) & 5:30 pm (church)

Sundays -**7:00 am** (church)

> 9:00 am (church and hall) 11:00 am (church and hall)

1:00 pm & 3:00 pm Traditional Latin mass (church)

5:30 pm (church and hall)

Please note that the priest, one server, 1-2 musicians, reader and ushers will be needed for each mass. This will allow for 42-44 parishioners to attend each mass. Attendance will be on a first come, first serve basis at this time. This is working very well. No one turned away!

This is only the first step in this new reality we presently find ourselves in, and hopefully the number of people allowed will steadily increase in the weeks/months ahead. His Excellency has continued to grant the dispensation to the faithful from attending the Sunday obligation of Mass until further notice (as he realizes that even those who may wish to attend simply cannot because of the restrictions). His Excellency also reminds the elderly 65 yrs and over and those who are not well, or who are undergoing treatments which weaken their immune defence to STAY HOME at this time. Confessions will remain as it is for now. (outside). Adoration is now back in the chapel. Please see open spots to fill for the Adoration chapel in the bulletin.

I encourage everyone to continue in your personal prayer life, and we will continue to livestream the Holy Mass and devotions here in our church through the livestream platform provided to us by Springfield funeral home.
