Office of the Bishop Update COVID 19

March 31, 2020



Dear Pastor, Parish Staff and Parishioners,

Greetings in the Lord! I am sending you this new update as we approach Holy Week and need to plan for the weeks ahead. Despite the challenges of the pandemic, it is vital to keep connected to our families, friends and faith communities. Fortunately, we live in a time when many forms of communication are available, and I encourage you to reach out regularly so that we can support one another and bolster each other's spirits. This may also mean materially assisting others with basic necessities, such as groceries or medication, etc

Our Christian and civic responsibility to protect one another and our community from exposure or infection from the corona virus continues, and our health and governmental authorities have given no concrete indication when the pandemic will end. Therefore:

- 1. Parish & Parish Offices: will remain closed to all members of the public until further notice.
- 2. Chrism Mass: will be postponed until such time we can safely gather as a diocesan family to celebrate.
- 3. Easter Triduum: will be live-streamed as has been done these last Sundays of Lent. We will strive to provide resources to help everyone participate. (The times for the celebrations are on the front page of this bulletin).
- 4. Funerals may be celebrated in our churches, but participation needs to be limited to **family members only** in compliance with current directive from the health authorities. No public reception following the funeral liturgy are to take place.
- 5. Faith life: I encourage everyone to continue to nourish and deepen your faith life by prayer, spiritual reading, on-line programs and acts of charity. Each morning, during this crisis, Mass is celebrated at 8:00 am preceded by the Rosary at 7:30 am, in Immaculate Conception Church in Kelowna. This Mass is live-streamed so that you can at least participate in that way. A link to this is found on the Immaculate Conception website icckelowna.ca and the diocesan website nelsondiocese.org. There is also a link to the Sunday mass, which I celebrate at 9:00 am preceded by the Rosary at 8:30 am.
- 6.
