We are following the protocols issued by our Bishop and the BC Health Authority to make sure that our worship space – the church & hall are safe and to ensure the safety and health of everyone who comes to celebrate our faith. A reminder for all to keep your social distance, use the appropriate in and out doors, and please take your conversations <u>outside</u> – <u>do not linger in the church</u> or hall before and after mass.

We still need you to volunteer! We will not be able to keep all the mass times we are offering if we don't have volunteers! Please leave your name and phone number on the flip chart boards at the exit of the church and hall before or after mass. Thank you so much for your help in this matter! The jobs are not hard and you will be shown what to do.

His Excellency has continued to grant the **dispensation to the faithful from attending the Sunday obligation of Mass** until further notice (as he realizes that even those who may wish to attend simply cannot because of the restrictions). His Excellency still reminds our seniors 65 yrs and over and those who are not well, or who are undergoing treatments which weaken their immune defence to STAY HOME at this time.

Confessions will remain as it is for now (outside). The Adoration chapel is open with restrictions.
